



## Huntsville FC Scholarship Information

Huntsville Futbol Club, as part of its mission, works to promote and develop a broad range of soccer opportunities for local youth players and their families. In an effort to provide increased opportunities for children and their families to participate in competitive soccer, Huntsville Futbol Club offers scholarship opportunities based on a combination of need and merit to those players from families that are eligible. Partial or full scholarships are available for Huntsville FC club dues which include coaching fees, state and local fees, player registration and administrative fees only. No scholarship is available to cover other team fees such as tournament entry fees, coaches' per diem or uniforms.

Huntsville FC Scholarships are awarded for one season (Fall) for competitive players. Scholarships are not based on level of play, soccer skills or athletic ability. Recipients are expected to perform volunteer work as requested. Eligible candidates must be registered with Huntsville FC. Scholarship opportunities are intended for players from families that have a documented financial need, and therefore applicants must complete and submit a competitive scholarship application. Information in applications will be used in determining eligible candidates for financial assistance. Huntsville FC will take reasonable measures to maintain confidentiality and assure that information will not be released to third parties. Huntsville FC reserves the right to request an applicant to reapply at any time, to request additional information or schedule an interview with an applicant.

Scholarship Applications for the upcoming season must be received in the Huntsville FC office by July 30, 2010.

Once the completed signed application is submitted, the Huntsville FC Scholarship committee will place the priority of consideration on the following criteria: Household income, families with single parents, employment of both parents, extenuating medical or family hardships. The Huntsville FC Scholarship Committee will meet on a regular and as-needed basis to consider all applications. Written notification of approval of scholarships will be made by mail or email. Submission of a scholarship application will eliminate eligibility of the applicant's family from serving as a team treasurer.
